- 8 (a) A support order or income-withholding order of
- 9 another state may be registered in this State by sending the
- 10 following documents and information to the appropriate

- 12 (1) a letter of transmittal to the tribunal
- requesting registration and enforcement;
- 14 (2) 2 copies, including one certified copy, of all
- orders to be registered, including any modification of an
