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AN ACT in relation to public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
changing Section 5-4.1 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-4.1) (from Ch. 23, par. 5-4.1)

Sec. 5-4.1. Co-payments. The Department may by rule 7 8 provide that recipients under any Article of this Code (other than group care recipients) shall pay a fee as a co-payment 9 for services. Co-payments may not exceed <u>\$1</u> one--dollar for 10 pharmacy services, physicians services, dental services, 11 12 optical services and supplies, chiropractic services, 13 podiatry services, and encounter rate clinic services. Co-payments may not exceed <u>\$3</u> three-dollars for hospital 14 outpatient and clinic services. 15 Notwithstanding any other 16 provision of this Section, co-payments for generic prescription drugs may not exceed \$0.50 per prescription. 17 Provided, however, that any such rule must provide that no 18 19 co-payment requirement can exist for renal dialysis, 20 radiation therapy, cancer chemotherapy, or insulin, and other products necessary on a recurring basis, the absence of which 21 22 would be life threatening, or where co-payment expenditures for required services and/or medications for chronic diseases 23 that the Illinois Department shall by rule designate shall 24 cause an extensive financial burden on the recipient, and 25 provided no co-payment shall exist for emergency room 26 27 encounters which are for medical emergencies.
