- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5.545 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.545 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5.546. Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity Scholarship Fund.</u>
- 8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 9 changing Section 3-412 and adding Section 3-648 as follows:
- 10 (625 ILCS 5/3-412) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-412)
- 11 Sec. 3-412. Registration plates and registration
- 12 stickers to be furnished by the Secretary of State.
- 13 (a) The Secretary of State upon registering a vehicle
- 14 subject to annual registration for the first time shall
- issue or shall cause to be issued to the owner one
- 16 registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer, semitrailer,
- 17 motorized pedalcycle or truck-tractor, 2 registration plates
- 18 for other motor vehicles and, where applicable, current
- 19 registration stickers for motor vehicles of the first
- 20 division. The provisions of this Section may be made
- 21 applicable to such vehicles of the second division, as the
- 22 Secretary of State may, from time to time, in his discretion
- 23 designate. On subsequent annual registrations during the term
- of the registration plate as provided in Section 3-414.1, the
- 25 Secretary shall issue or cause to be issued registration
- 26 stickers as evidence of current registration. However, the
- 27 issuance of annual registration stickers to vehicles
- 28 registered under the provisions of Section 3-402.1 of this
- 29 Code may not be required if the Secretary deems the issuance

1 unnecessary.

- 2 Every registration plate shall have displayed upon the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which 3 4 is issued, the name of this State, which may 5 abbreviated, the year number for which it was issued, which 6 may be abbreviated, the phrase "Land of Lincoln", except provided in Sections 3-626, 3-628, 3-629, 3-633, 3-634, 7 3-637, 3-638, and 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, and 3-648, and such 8 9 other letters or numbers as the Secretary may prescribe. However, for apportionment plates issued to vehicles 10 registered under Section 3-402.1, the phrase "Land of 11 Lincoln" may be omitted to allow for the word "apportioned" 12 The Secretary may in his discretion 13 to be displayed. letters be used as prefixes only on 14 prescribe that registration plates issued to vehicles of the first division 15 16 which are registered under this Code and only as suffixes on registration plates issued to other 17 vehicles. Every 18 registration sticker issued as evidence of current 19 registration shall designate the year number for which it is issued and such other letters or numbers as the Secretary may 20 prescribe and shall be of a contrasting color with the 21 22 registration plates and registration stickers of the previous 23 year.
 - (c) Each registration plate and the required letters and numerals thereon, except the year number for which issued, shall be of sufficient size to be plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight, and shall be coated with reflectorizing material. The dimensions of the plate issued to vehicles of the first division shall be 6 by 12 inches.
- 31 (d) The Secretary of State shall issue for every 32 passenger motor vehicle rented without a driver the same type 33 of registration plates as the type of plates issued for a 34 private passenger vehicle.

- 1 (e) The Secretary of State shall issue for every 2 passenger car used as a taxicab or livery, distinctive 3 registration plates.
- 4 (f) The Secretary of State shall issue for every 5 motorcycle distinctive registration plates distinguishing 6 between motorcycles having 150 or more cubic centimeters 7 piston displacement, or having less than 150 cubic centimeter 8 piston displacement.
- 9 (g) Registration plates issued to vehicles for-hire may 10 display a designation as determined by the Secretary that 11 such vehicles are for-hire.
- 12 (h) The Secretary of State shall issue for each electric
 13 vehicle distinctive registration plates which shall
 14 distinguish between electric vehicles having a maximum
 15 operating speed of 45 miles per hour or more and those having
 16 a maximum operating speed of less than 45 miles per hour.

- (i) The Secretary of State shall issue for every public and private ambulance registration plates identifying the vehicle as an ambulance. The Secretary shall forward to the Department of Public Aid registration information for the purpose of verification of claims filed with the Department by ambulance owners for payment for services to public assistance recipients.
- (j) The Secretary of State shall issue for every public 24 25 medical carrier or rescue vehicle livery private registration plates displaying numbers within ranges of 26 numbers reserved respectively for medical carriers and rescue 27 vehicles. The Secretary shall forward to the Department of 28 Public Aid registration information for the purpose of 29 30 verification of claims filed with the Department by owners of medical carriers or rescue vehicles for payment for services 31 32 to public assistance recipients.

- 4 <u>Sec. 3-648. Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity license plates.</u>
- 5 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
- 6 <u>Secretary</u>, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
- 7 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
- 8 State, may issue special registration plates designated as
- 9 Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity license plates to residents of
- 10 <u>Illinois who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the</u>
- 11 <u>Secretary of State.</u> The special plate issued under this
- 12 <u>Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the</u>
- 13 first division, motor vehicles of the second division
- 14 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds, and recreational
- 15 <u>vehicles</u> as <u>defined</u> by <u>Section 1-169 of this Code</u>. <u>Plates</u>
- 16 <u>issued under this Section shall expire according to the</u>
- 17 <u>staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1</u>

- 19 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be
- 20 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State,
- 21 <u>except that the Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity Insignia shall</u>
- 22 <u>appear on the plates. The Secretary may, in his or her</u>
- 23 <u>discretion</u>, allow the <u>plates</u> to be issued as vanity or
- 24 personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of
- 25 <u>this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of</u>
- Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of
- 27 <u>this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility</u>
- 28 <u>requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and</u>
- 29 prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.
- 30 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for original
- 31 <u>issuance</u> in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of
- 32 this additional fee, \$15 shall be deposited into the
- 33 <u>Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund and \$5 shall be</u>

1 deposited into the Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity Scholarship Fund. 2 For each registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition 3 to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of 4 this additional fee, \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund and \$18 shall be 5 6 deposited into the Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity Scholarship Fund. 7 (d) The Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity Scholarship Fund is 8 created as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys 9 in the Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity Scholarship Fund shall, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval 10 by the Secretary, be used by the Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity 11 Scholarship Foundation Inc., a recognized charitable 12 13 organization that meets the requirements of Title 26, Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Code, to provide grants for 14 scholarships for higher education. The scholarship recipients 15 16 must be undergraduate members of an Illinois Chapter of Phi Kappa Psi and must be Illinois residents and must attend a 17 college or university located within the State of Illinois. 18 The State Treasurer shall require the Phi Kappa Psi 19 Fraternity Scholarship Foundation to establish a separate 20 account for receipt of the proceeds of the Phi Kappa Psi 2.1 Fraternity Scholarship Fund. That account shall be subject to 22 23 audit either annually or at another interval, as determined by the State Treasurer. Proceeds from the Phi Kappa Psi 24 Fraternity Scholarship Fund shall be transferred on a 25 quarterly basis by the State Treasurer's office to this 26 27 separate account.
