AN ACT in relation to support.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
changing Section 10-2 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/10-2) (from Ch. 23, par. 10-2)

Sec. 10-2. Extent of Liability. A husband is liable for 7 8 the support of his wife and a wife for the support of her husband. The parents are severally liable for the support of 9 any child under age 21, except that a parent is not liable 10 for a child age 18 or over if <u>the</u> such child is not 11 living with the parent or parents, and a parent is not liable for a 12 13 child of any age if the child has married and is not living with the parent or parents. A child shall be considered to be 14 living with the parent or parents if the such child is absent 15 16 from the parent's or parents' home only in order to regularly a school, college or university or to receive 17 attend technical training designed for preparation for gainful 18 employment. The term "child" includes a child born out of 19 20 wedlock, or legally adopted child.

In addition to the primary obligation of support imposed 21 22 upon responsible relatives, such relatives, if individually or together in any combination they have sufficient income or 23 other resources to support a needy person, in whole or in 24 part, shall be liable for any financial aid extended under 25 26 this Code to a person for whose support they are responsible, 27 including amounts expended for funeral and burial costs.
