- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by
- 5 changing Section 21-6 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/21-6) (from Ch. 38, par. 21-6)
- 7 Sec. 21-6. Unauthorized Possession or Storage of Weapons.
- 8 (a) Whoever possesses or stores any weapon enumerated in
- 9 Section 33A-1 in any building or on land supported in whole
- 10 or in part with public funds or in any building on such land
- 11 without prior written permission from the chief security
- 12 officer for such land or building commits a Class A
- 13 misdemeanor.
- 14 (a-5) Whoever possesses a BB gun, pellet gun, air gun, or
- 15 <u>any device manufactured and designed to be substantially</u>
- 16 <u>similar in appearance to a firearm in a school building,</u>
- 17 <u>school bus, or real estate comprising a school without prior</u>
- 18 <u>written permission from the chief security officer for that</u>
- 19 <u>school commits a Class A misdemeanor.</u>
- 20 (b) The chief security officer must grant any reasonable
- 21 request for permission under paragraph (a) or (a-5).
