Necessity of license; exemptions. 8 9 (a) It is unlawful for any person, corporation, limited 10 liability company, partnership, or other entity to conduct an 11 auction, provide an auction service, hold himself or herself out as an auctioneer, or advertise his or her services as an 12 auctioneer in the State of Illinois without a license issued 13 14 by OBRE under this Act, except at: (1) an auction conducted solely by or for 15 а not-for-profit organization for charitable purposes; 16 (2) an auction conducted by the owner of the 17 property, real or personal; 18 (3) an auction for the sale or lease of real 19 property conducted by a licensee under the Real Estate 20 21 License Act, or its successor Acts, in accordance with 22 the terms of that Act; and

1 (4) an auction conducted by a business registered 2 a market agency under the federal Packers and as Stockyards Act (7 U.S.C. 181 et seq.) or under the 3 4 Livestock Auction Market Law; -

5 (5) an auction conducted by an agent, officer, or employee of a federal agency in the conduct of his or her 6 7 official duties; and

8 (6) an auction conducted by an agent, officer, or 9 employee of the State government or any political subdivision thereof performing his or her official 10 11 duties.

(b) Nothing in this Act shall be construed to apply to a 12 vehicle dealer licensed by the Secretary of State of 13 Illinois, or to any employee of the licensee, who is a 14 resident of the State of Illinois, while the employee is 15 16 acting in the regular scope of his or her employment for the licensee while conducting an auction that is not open to the 17 public, provided that only new or used vehicle dealers 18 19 licensed by the Secretary of State or licensed by another jurisdiction may buy property at the auction 7-0r-to-sales-by 20 21 or-through-the-licensee.

(c) Nothing in this Act shall be construed to prohibit a 22 23 person under the age of 18 from selling property under \$250 in value while under the direct supervision of a licensed 24 25 auctioneer.
