- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 2-3.131 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.131 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2-3.131. Bonuses for new teachers. The State Board</u>
- 8 <u>of Education shall implement a program to provide</u>
- 9 State-funded bonuses to new fully certified teachers who
- 10 agree to teach in a school on the academic watch list under
- 11 <u>Section 2-3.25d of this Code or in a critical teacher</u>
- 12 <u>shortage discipline</u>, with additional bonuses awarded for

- 8 <u>Commission shall implement a loan forgiveness program for</u>
- 9 students enrolled in a course of study leading to teacher
- 10 <u>certification at an institution of higher learning who agree</u>
- 11 to teach in a school on the academic watch list under Section
- 12 <u>2-3.25d of the School Code for a specified period of time.</u>
- 13 <u>Under this program, 15% of a student's higher education loans</u>
- 14 shall be forgiven for each of the first and second years of
