- 2 WHEREAS, There are thousands of undocumented Mexican
- 3 children residing in the State of Illinois that are unable to
- 4 attend State colleges or universities after the completion of

- 6 WHEREAS, The City of Chicago currently has the second
- 7 largest Mexican population in the United States; therefore,
- 8 be it
- 9 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 10 NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 11 we urge the State of Illinois and the government of Mexico,
- 12 through its representatives in Illinois and the Consulate
- 13 General of Mexico, to work together to create a reciprocal
- 14 program that would allow Illinois residents to attend Mexican
- 15 colleges at resident tuition rates and Mexican residents,
- irrespective of their migratory status, to attend Illinois'
- 17 public colleges and universities at resident tuition rates;
- 18 and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the State of Illinois is further urged to
- 20 follow the lead of the State of California by creating a
- 21 reciprocal scholarship program whereby a certain number of
- 22 Illinois citizens would receive tuition waivers to attend
- 23 institutions of higher education in Mexico and a certain
- 24 number of Mexican citizens would receive tuition waivers to
- 25 attend institutions of higher education in Illinois; and be
- 26 it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- delivered to the Consulate General of Mexico, Carlos M. Sada,
- 29 to the Chairman of the Board of Higher Education, and to the
- 30 Chairman of the Illinois Community College Board.
