

AN ACT with regard to education.

Be it enacted by the People of the state of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 27-22 as follows:
(105 ILCS 5/27-22) (from Ch. 122, par. 27-22)
Sec. 27-22. Required high school courses.
(a) As a prerequisite to receiving a high school diploma, each pupil entering the 9th grade in 1984-1985 and subsequent years before the $2001-2002$ school year must, in addition to other course requirements, successfully complete the following courses:
(1) $7-$ three years of language arts;
(2) $z$ - two years of mathematics, one of which may be related to computer technology;
(3) 3- one year of science;
(4) 4- two years of social studies, of which at least one year must be history of the United States or a combination of history of the United States and American government; and
(5) 5- One year chosen from (A) music, (B) art, (C) foreign language, which shall be deemed to include American Sign Language or (D) vocational education.

This amendatory Act of 1983 does not apply to pupils entering the $9 t h$ grade in 1983-1984 school year and prior school years or to students with disabilities whose course of study is determined by an individualized education program.
(b) As a prerequisite to receiving a high school diploma, each pupil entering the 9th grade in the 2001-2002 school year or a subsequent school year must, in addition to other course requirements, successfully complete all of the
following courses:
(1) Four years of English.
(2) Three years of mathematics, one of which may be related to computer technology.
(3) Three years of science.
(4) Three years of social studies, of which at least one year must be history of the United States or a combination of history of the United States and American government.
(5) Two years of a foreign language, which is deemed to include American Sign Language.
(6) Two years of fine arts, which may include one year of art or drafting and one year of music.
(7) Two years of physical education.

This amendatory Act of the 92 nd General Assembly does not apply to pupils entering the 9th grade in the 2000-2001 school year or a prior school year or to students with disabilities whose course of study is determined by an individualized education program.
(c) The provisions of this Section are subject to the provisions of Section 27-22.05.
