- Sec. 2-3.131. Prekindergarten program.
- 8 (a) The State Board of Education shall develop
- 9 guidelines for and administer a prekindergarten program. The
- 10 program shall be available each school year on a voluntary
- 11 <u>basis to all children who are 4 years of age on September 1</u>
- and whose parents are residents of this State.
- 13 (b) The school readiness goal of the program shall be to
- 14 provide a developmentally appropriate preschool program
- emphasizing growth in each of the following areas:
- 16 <u>(1) Language and literacy, with activities for</u>
- 17 <u>children participating in the program including without</u>
- 18 <u>limitation understanding and telling stories, recognizing</u>
- 19 <u>pictures, words, and stories, recognizing the alphabet,</u>
- and understanding that writing is communication.

13	without limitation playing and working cooperatively,

16	(c) Goals for parents whose children are in the program
17	shall include without limitation actively participating in

19	home environment and school success, and being aware of
