- 7 Sec. 20-7. Place and terms of sale.
- 8 (a) The court may designate the place and manner of
- 9 holding the sale, whether private or public, and whether for
- 10 cash or on reasonable credit. The sale may be conducted by
- 11 means of the Internet or any other electronic medium as
- 12 approved by the court. When mining, oil or gas rights only
- 13 are sold, the court may require security of the purchaser and
- 14 may direct the sale to be made upon a royalty basis or for a
- lump sum in such manner and upon such terms as appears to the
- 16 court to be to the best interests of the estate.
- 17 (b) Every public sale under this Article, except a sale
- 18 <u>conducted</u> by means of the Internet or another electronic
- 19 <u>medium,</u> shall be held between the hours of 10:00 o'clock in

- 21 day. Notice of the time, place and terms of holding the
