## 1 SENATE RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, There are over 1,430 townships in Illinois
- 3 serving a majority of Illinois citizens throughout the State;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, Township government is the local government
- 6 closest to the people in Illinois providing services not
- 7 otherwise available; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Townships serve residents of unincorporated
- 9 areas by providing essential services such as roads, social
- 10 services, and transportation and may also provide specialized
- 11 services including youth and senior services, health care,
- 12 recycling, and libraries; and
- 13 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND
- 14 GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, That the Senate
- 15 Task Force on Township Government is hereby created to be
- 16 composed of seven members, four appointed by the Senate
- 17 President and three appointed by the Senate Minority Leader;
- 18 and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, The seven members of the Task Force shall be
- 20 members of the Illinois State Senate (one of whom shall be
- 21 designated as the Chairperson by the Senate President); and
- 22 be it further
- 23 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall examine various
- 24 issues relating to township government including, but not
- 25 limited to: modernizing township operations, streamlining
- 26 provision of service, and improving government programs, and
- 27 be it further
- 28 RESOLVED, That the Task Force on Township Government
- 29 shall submit a final report to the Senate on or before
- 30 December 31, 2001.
