AN ACT concerning local government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by changing Section 10.11 as follows:

(50 ILCS 705/10.11)

Sec. 10.11. Training; death and homicide investigation. The Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board shall conduct or approve a training program in death and homicide investigation for the training of law enforcement officers of local government agencies <u>and coroners</u>. Only law enforcement officers <u>and coroners</u> who successfully complete the training program may be assigned as lead investigators in death and homicide investigations <u>and coroner's investigations, respectively</u>. Satisfactory completion of the training program shall be evidenced by a certificate issued to the law enforcement officer <u>or coroner</u> by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board.

The Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board shall develop a process for waiver applications sent by <u>a local</u> <u>law enforcement</u> the agency administrator <u>or from a coroner's</u> <u>office</u> for those officers <u>or coroners</u> whose prior training and experience as homicide investigators may qualify them for a Public Act 097-1009

waiver. The Board may issue a waiver at its discretion, based solely on the prior training and experience of an officer <u>or a</u> <u>coroner</u> as a homicide investigator. <u>This Section does not</u> <u>affect or impede the powers of the office of the coroner to</u> <u>investigate all deaths as provided in Division 3-3 of the</u> <u>Counties Code.</u>
