AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Commission to End the Disparities Facing the African-American Community Act is amended by changing Sections 15 and 95 as follows:

Sec. 15. Meetings; report. The Commission shall:

- (1) research the disparities facing African-Americans in the areas of healthcare, healthcare services, employment, education, criminal justice, housing, and other social and economic issues;
- (2) hold one or more public hearings, at which public testimony shall be heard; and
- (3) report its findings and specific recommendations to the General Assembly on or before December 31, $\underline{2015}$ $\underline{2013}$, after which the Commission shall dissolve.
