AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Law Enforcement Information Task Force Act is amended by changing Sections 20 and 25 as follows:

(20 ILCS 5090/20)

Sec. 20. Preliminary and final report.

- (a) The Task Force shall provide a preliminary report to the Governor and General Assembly on or before $\underline{\text{July 15, 2017}}$ December 15, 2016, if the final report is not completed by then.
- (b) The Task Force shall issue a final report to the Governor and General Assembly on or before October 15 January 15, 2017. The report shall include recommendations for legislation, use of technology, and other non-legislative processes that would improve the criminal discovery process and law enforcement information sharing.
