Executive: **Senate Amendment No. 2 to House Bill 1285.**

Senator Weaver Chairperson of the Committee on Rules, to which was referred **House Bill No. 2610**, on June 27, 1999, pursuant to Rule 3-9(b), reported that the Committee recommends that the bill be approved for consideration and returned to the calendar in its former position.

The report of the Committee was concurred in.

And **House Bill No. 2610**, was returned to the order of second reading.
