4	(b) Each school board shall require in-service training for
5	school personnel to include training to develop cultural
6	competency, including understanding and reducing implicit

8	(c) As used in this Section, "implicit racial bias" means a
9	preference, positive or negative, for a racial or ethnic group
10	that operates outside of awareness. This bias has 3 different
11	components: affective, behavioral, and cognitive.

14	(a) The General Assembly makes the following findings:

20	access to educators who have worked to reduce their biases;

22	(4) training that helps educators overcome implicit
23	racial bias has implication for classroom interactions,
24	student evaluation, and classroom engagement; it also
25	affects student academic self-concept.

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1	(b) The board shall require in-service training for school
2	personnel to include training to develop cultural competency,
3	including understanding and reducing implicit racial bias.

- (c) As used in this Section, "implicit racial bias" means a preference, positive or negative, for a racial or ethnic group that operates outside of awareness. This bias has 3 different components: affective, behavioral, and cognitive.
