1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1445

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1445 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing
5 Section 1-12 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/1-12)

7 Sec. 1-12. Public university voting.

8 (a) Each appropriate election authority shall, in addition
9 to the early voting conducted at locations otherwise required
10 by law, conduct early voting, grace period registration, and
11 grace period voting at the student union or another accessible
12 building on the campus of a public university within the
13 election authority's jurisdiction. The voting required by this
14 subsection (a) to be conducted on campus must be conducted
15 from the 6th day before a general primary or general election
16 through the day before a general primary or general election

1 for a consecutive period of 7 hours each day and on the day of
2 a general primary or general election from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00
3 p.m. until and including the 4th day before a general primary
4 or general election from 10:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. and must be
5 conducted as otherwise required by Article 19A of this Code.
6 The , ~~except that the~~ voting required by this subsection (a)
7 need not be conducted during a consolidated primary or
8 consolidated election. If an election authority has voting
9 equipment that can accommodate a ballot in every form required
10 in the election authority's jurisdiction, then the election
11 authority shall extend early voting and grace period
12 registration and voting under this Section to any registered
13 voter in the election authority's jurisdiction. However, if
14 the election authority does not have voting equipment that can
15 accommodate a ballot in every form required in the election
16 authority's jurisdiction, then the election authority may
17 limit early voting and grace period registration and voting
18 under this Section to voters in precincts where the public
19 university is located and precincts bordering the university.
20 Each public university shall make the space available at the
21 student union for, and cooperate and coordinate with the
22 appropriate election authority in, the implementation of this
23 subsection (a).

25 (c) For the purposes of this Section, "public university"
26 means the University of Illinois, Illinois State University,

1 Chicago State University, Governors State University, Southern
2 Illinois University, Northern Illinois University, Eastern
3 Illinois University, Western Illinois University, and
4 Northeastern Illinois University.

5 (d) For the purposes of this Section, "student union"
6 means the Student Center at 750 S. Halsted on the University of
7 Illinois-Chicago campus; the Public Affairs Center at the
8 University of Illinois at Springfield or a new building
9 completed after the effective date of this Act housing student
10 government at the University of Illinois at Springfield; the
11 Illini Union at the University of Illinois at
12 Urbana-Champaign; the SIUC Student Center at the Southern
13 Illinois University at Carbondale campus; the Morris
14 University Center at the Southern Illinois University at
15 Edwardsville campus; the University Union at the Western
16 Illinois University at the Macomb campus; the Holmes Student
17 Center at the Northern Illinois University campus; the
18 University Union at the Eastern Illinois University campus;
19 NEIU Student Union at the Northeastern Illinois University
20 campus; the Bone Student Center at the Illinois State
21 University campus; the Cordell Reed Student Union at the
22 Chicago State University campus; and the Hall of Governors in
23 Building D at the Governors State University campus.
