1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2072

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2072 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources
5 (Conservation) Law of the Civil Administrative Code of
6 Illinois is amended by adding Section 805-585 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 805/805-585 new)

8 Sec. 805-585. World Shooting and Recreational Complex
9 ammunition sales. Subject to the requirements of State and
10 federal law and subject to Section 15 of the Department of
11 Natural Resources World Shooting and Recreational Complex Act,
12 the Department may sell ammunition at the World Shooting and
13 Recreational Complex and to contract that right to a
14 contractor.

15 Section 10. The Department of Natural Resources World

1 Shooting and Recreational Complex Act is amended by changing
2 Section 15 as follows:

3 (20 ILCS 861/15)

4 Sec. 15. Authority to enter into public-private agreement;
5 ammunition sales.

6 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
7 the Department, on behalf of the State, may enter into a
8 public-private agreement to develop, finance, lease, manage,
9 and operate the World Shooting and Recreational Complex on
10 behalf of the State, pursuant to which the contractors may
11 receive certain revenues, including management or user fees in
12 consideration of the payment of moneys to the State for that
13 right.

14 (b) Subject to the requirements of State and federal law,
15 the Department may sell ammunition at the World Shooting and
16 Recreational Complex and may contract the right to sell
17 ammunition to a contractor in a public-private agreement.
18 Revenue from the sale of ammunition at the World Shooting and
19 Recreational Complex by the Department or its contractor under
20 a public-private agreement under this Section, except for
21 operating and non-operating costs and expenses related to the
22 sale of ammunition, shall be deposited into the State Parks
23 Fund to the credit of a special account designated as the World
24 Shooting and Recreational Complex Ammunition Account. All
25 moneys credited to the World Shooting and Recreational Complex

1 Ammunition Account shall be used for any purposes related to
2 the World Shooting and Recreational Complex and for no other
3 purpose. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to
4 affect the applicability or scope of any provision of the
5 Firearm Owners Identification Card Act, the Criminal Code of
6 2012, or any other law.
