#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 440/4	from Ch. 121, par. 504
225 ILCS 440/4.09 new	
225 ILCS 440/5	from Ch. 121, par. 505

Amends Highway Advertising Control Act of 1971. Provides that signs that advertise a business, including, but not limited to, a gas station, shall be allowed on the eastbound and westbound lanes of Interstate highway 90 before Exit 25 (Genoa Road). Makes conforming changes.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Highway Advertising Control Act of 1971 is  
5 amended by changing Sections 4 and 5 and by adding Section 4.09  
6 as follows:

7 (225 ILCS 440/4) (from Ch. 121, par. 504)

8 Sec. 4. Signs shall not be erected or maintained along  
9 primary or Interstate highways except those described in  
10 Sections 4.01 through 4.09 ~~4.08~~.

12 (225 ILCS 440/4.09 new)

13 Sec. 4.09. Signs on Interstate highway 90. Signs that  
14 advertise a business, including, but not limited to, a gas  
15 station, shall be allowed on the eastbound and westbound lanes  
16 of Interstate highway 90 before Exit 25 (Genoa Road).

17 (225 ILCS 440/5) (from Ch. 121, par. 505)

18 Sec. 5. No sign may be erected or maintained that:

19 (a) Imitates or resembles an official traffic sign, signal  
20 or device;

21 (b) Is erected, painted or drawn upon trees, rocks or

1 other natural features;

2 (c) Is structurally unsafe or in disrepair; or

3 (d) Is erected adjacent to a scenic byway that is a primary  
4 or Interstate highway after the effective date of this  
5 amendatory Act of 1996, except those signs described in  
6 Sections 4.01, 4.02, 4.03, 4.06, ~~and 4.08~~, and 4.09 of this  
7 Act.
