### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$352,200,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for grants and administrative expenses of the Home Illinois Program. Effective July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$352,200,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
6 Fund to the Department of Human Services for grants and  
7 administrative expenses of the Home Illinois Program,  
8 including pilot programs, to prevent and end homelessness in  
9 Illinois, including, but not limited to, homelessness  
10 prevention, emergency and transitional housing, rapid  
11 rehousing, outreach, and related services and supports for  
12 individuals at risk or experiencing homelessness, including  
13 homeless veterans, in the approximate amounts below:
