2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 5195 on page 1,
3 lines 8 and 9, by replacing "Illinois Future of Energy Choice
4 and Economic Impact Commission" with "Illinois Future of
5 Energy Affordability, Reliability, and Economic Impact
6 Commission"; and

7 on page 1, line 11, by replacing "choice" with "reliability";
8 and

9 on page 2, lines 16 and 17, by replacing "The Illinois Future
10 of Energy Choice and Economic Impact Commission" with "The
11 Illinois Future of Energy Affordability, Reliability, and
12 Economic Impact Commission"; and

13 on page 3, line 11, after "gas" by inserting "distribution";
14 and

1 on page 3, immediately below line 16, by inserting the
2 following:

3 "(11) 2 members representing natural gas generation
4 utilities, appointed by the Director of Commerce and
5 Economic Opportunity;

6 (12) one member representing a statewide association
7 that represents farmers or the agricultural industry,
8 appointed by the Director of Commerce and Economic
9 Opportunity;

10 (13) up to 3 additional members, appointed by the
11 Director of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, from
12 community-based organizations representing community
13 interests in climate or environmental policy;"; and

14 on page 3, line 17, by replacing "(11)" with "(14)"; and

15 on page 3, by replacing lines 21 through 23 with the following:

16 "(15) 2 members representing a statewide business
17 organization, including one member representing a
18 statewide organization representing manufacturers,
19 appointed by the Director of Commerce and Economic
20 Opportunity;"; and

21 on page 3, line 24, by replacing "(13)" with "(16)"; and

22 on page 4, line 1, by replacing "(14)" with "(17)"; and

1 on page 4, line 4, by replacing "(15)" with "(18)"; and

2 on page 4, line 8, by replacing "(16)" with "(19)"; and

3 on page 5, immediately below line 21, by inserting the
4 following:

5 "(5) to analyze and evaluate existing or proposed
6 State or local laws or regulations that may impede or seek
7 to impede specific types of energy sources from being used
8 by either residential or commercial customers;"; and

9 on page 5, line 22, by replacing "(5)" with "(6)"; and

10 on page 6, line 1, by replacing "(6)" with "(7)"; and

11 on page 6, line 4, by deleting "and"; and

12 on page 6, line 5, by replacing "(7)" with "(8)"; and

13 on page 6, line 8, by replacing the period with "; and"; and

14 on page 6, immediately below line 8, by inserting the
15 following:

16 "(9) to consider, study, or analyze additional topics
17 that the Commission may deem necessary related to energy

1 policies, regulations, or legislation in the State and the
2 economic impact of those policies, regulations, or
3 legislation."; and

4 on page 6, by deleting line 12.
