SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$500,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant to the Rich Township Chamber of Commerce for the purpose of making subgrant payments to small businesses for technical assistance, training equipment, operations, programming, training facilities, and curriculum implementation. Effective July 1, 2026.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of that amount
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
7 for a grant to the Rich Township Chamber of Commerce for the
8 purpose of making subgrant payments to small businesses for
9 technical assistance, training equipment, operations,
10 programming, training facilities, and curriculum
