SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/8.57

Amends the State Finance Act. Repeals provisions requiring transfers to the Budget Reserve for Immediate Disbursements and Governmental Emergencies Fund from the State Pheasant Fund, the State Migratory Waterfowl Stamp Fund, the Fish and Wildlife Endowment Fund, and the Illinois Habitat Fund.

A BILL FOR

AN ACT concerning finance.

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
represented in the General Assembly:**

Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by changing
Section 8.57 as follows:

(30 ILCS 105/8.57)

Sec. 8.57. Transfers to the BRIDGE Fund. Notwithstanding
any other State law to the contrary, on the effective date this
amendatory Act of the 104th General Assembly or as soon
thereafter as is practical, but in no circumstance later than
July 31, 2025, the State Comptroller shall direct and the
State Treasurer shall transfer the following amounts from the
funds specified to the Budget Reserve for Immediate
Disbursements and Governmental Emergencies Fund:
