12 Department of Corrections, and the Illinois Department of
13 Transportation throughout his career; and

14 WHEREAS, Aaron Pittman-Teague was deeply involved in
15 giving back to his community, including coaching youth

17 WHEREAS, Aaron Pittman-Teague loved sports and fishing; he
18 was a passionate music enthusiast who dedicated much of his
19 time in the studio, managing artists and recording his own
20 music; his work as a creative sound engineer earned him
21 credits in various films, and he owned a label in partnership

3 gentle giant, was known for his kindness, humor, generosity,
4 infectious energy, and his passion for his family; and

5 WHEREAS, Aaron Teague-Pittman was preceded in death by his

7 Waneda Pittman; and

8 WHEREAS, Aaron Teague-Pittman is survived by his wife,
9 Melissa; his stepdaughter, Emery; his parents; his
10 grandmother, Ruthel Teague; his siblings, Zaida Teague-Calvin,
11 Jordan Teague, TyKeisha Washington, Rochaud Alexander Pittman,
12 Sydney Doyal, Taylor Doyal, Skyler Pittman, and London
