SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

415 ILCS 5/19.12 new

Amends the Environmental Protection Act. Provides that, for the purpose of ensuring that there is appropriated to the Agency on an annual basis the funding necessary to address the risk to public health and safety caused by emerging drinking water contaminants that have the potential to threaten drinking water supplies in the State, there is hereby appropriated, on a continuing annual basis in each fiscal year, from the General Revenue Fund to the Agency, the amount, if any, by which the total appropriation to the Agency from the General Revenue Fund for that fiscal year for that express purpose is less than \$5,000,000.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by
5 adding Section 19.12 as follows:

6 (415 ILCS 5/19.12 new)

7 Sec. 19.12. Continuing appropriation to address emerging
8 drinking water contaminants. For the purpose of ensuring that
9 there is appropriated to the Agency on an annual basis the
10 funding necessary to address the risk to public health and
11 safety caused by emerging drinking water contaminants that
12 have the potential to threaten drinking water supplies in the
13 State, there is hereby appropriated, on a continuing annual
14 basis in each fiscal year, from the General Revenue Fund to the
15 Agency, the amount, if any, by which the total appropriation
16 to the Agency from the General Revenue Fund for that fiscal
17 year for that express purpose is less than \$5,000,000.
