SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/11-6.1.5 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that a municipality must set aside, in a dedicated account, 25% of the funds the municipality receives from an insurer on account of ambulance or fire services provided by the municipality. Provides that the municipality may only use the funds in the dedicated account for purchasing and maintaining ambulances, fire engines, and other vehicles used to provide emergency services.

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
5 adding Section 11-6.1.5 as follows:

7 Sec. 11-6.1.5. Minimum funding requirements for
8 ambulances, fire engines, and other vehicles used to provide
9 emergency services. A municipality must set aside, in a
10 dedicated account, 25% of the funds the municipality receives
11 from an insurer on account of ambulance or fire services
12 provided by the municipality. The municipality may only use
13 the funds in the dedicated account for purchasing and
14 maintaining ambulances, fire engines, and other vehicles used
