2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2215 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Department of Public Health Act is amended  
5 by adding Section 8.5 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 2305/8.5 new)

7 Sec. 8.5. Information for distribution concerning  
8 fertility options.

9 (a) As used in this Section, "health care professional"  
10 means a physician licensed under the Medical Practice Act of  
11 1987, a podiatrist licensed under the Podiatric Medical  
12 Practice Act of 1987, an advanced practice registered nurse  
13 licensed under the Nurse Practice Act, or a physician  
14 assistant licensed under the Physician Assistant Practice Act  
15 of 1987.

16 (b) The Department of Public Health shall provide the

1 following clinical, evidence-based information to health care  
2 professionals that may be distributed to women over the age of  
3 25 years, or women interested in information about future  
4 fertility, including, but not limited to:

5 (1) a description of the factors impacting fertility,  
6 including the ovarian reserve;

7 (2) an overview of different types of means to assess  
8 fertility, including ovarian reserve testing and the  
9 limitations of the tests; and

10 (3) information on potential results and resources  
11 that are available after testing and any additional  
12 information that should be considered by a patient  
13 undergoing the test."
