2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2427, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 1, on page 4, by replacing lines 5 through 7 with the
5 following:

6 "(f) The development of the policy required in subsection
7 (b) shall include input from the school community, including
8 teachers, staff, administrators, students, and parents. Each
9 school board shall review its wireless communication device
10 policy at least once every 3 years and make any necessary and
11 appropriate revisions to the policy. During this review, each
12 school board shall engage the community, including teachers,
13 staff, administrators, students, and parents, for input and
14 consider any available data on student discipline. The
15 development and review of the wireless communication device
16 policy in this subsection (f) may be accomplished through the
17 use of the parent-teacher advisory committee set forth in
18 Section 10-20.14 of this Code."; and

5 charter school shall review its wireless communication device
6 policy at least once every 3 years and make any necessary and
7 appropriate revisions to the policy. During this review, each
8 charter school shall engage the community, including teachers,
9 staff, administrators, students, and parents, for input and
10 consider any available data on student discipline. The
11 development and review of the wireless communication device
12 policy in this subsection (f) may be accomplished through the
13 use of the parent-teacher advisory committee set forth in
14 Section 10-20.14 of this Code."; and

15 and on page 10, by replacing lines 3 through 5 with the
16 following:

17 "(f) The development of the policy required in subsection
18 (b) shall include input from the school community, including
19 teachers, staff, administrators, students, and parents. The
20 board shall review its wireless communication device policy at
21 least once every 3 years and make any necessary and
22 appropriate revisions to the policy. During this review, the
23 board shall engage the community, including teachers, staff,
24 administrators, students, and parents, for input and consider

1 any available data on student discipline. The development and
2 review of the wireless communication device policy in this
3 subsection (f) may be accomplished through the use of the
4 parent-teacher advisory committee set forth in Section
5 10-20.14 of this Code.".
