1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2755

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2755 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Toll Highway Act is amended by changing
5 Section 19 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 10/19) (from Ch. 121, par. 100-19)

7 (Text of Section before amendment by P.A. 104-457)

8 Sec. 19. Toll rates. The Authority shall fix and revise
9 from time to time, tolls or charges or rates for the privilege
10 of using each of the toll highways constructed pursuant to
11 this Act. Such tolls shall be so fixed and adjusted at rates
12 calculated to provide the lowest reasonable toll rates that
13 will provide funds sufficient with other revenues of the
14 Authority to pay, (a) the cost of the construction of a toll
15 highway authorized by joint resolution of the General Assembly
16 pursuant to Section 14.1 and the reconstruction, major repairs

1 or improvements of toll highways, (b) the cost of maintaining,
2 repairing, regulating and operating the toll highways
3 including only the necessary expenses of the Authority, and
4 (c) the principal of all bonds, interest thereon and all
5 sinking fund requirements and other requirements provided by
6 resolutions authorizing the issuance of the bonds as they
7 shall become due. In fixing the toll rates pursuant to this
8 Section 19 and Section 10(c) of this Act, the Authority shall
9 take into account the effect of the provisions of this Section
10 19 permitting the use of the toll highway system without
11 payment of the covenants of the Authority contained in the
12 resolutions and trust indentures authorizing the issuance of
13 bonds of the Authority. No such provision permitting the use
14 of the toll highway system without payment of tolls after the
15 date of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall
16 be applied in a manner that impairs the rights of bondholders
17 pursuant to any resolution or trust indentures authorizing the
18 issuance of bonds of the Authority. The use and disposition of
19 any sinking or reserve fund shall be subject to such
20 regulation as may be provided in the resolution or trust
21 indenture authorizing the issuance of the bonds. Subject to
22 the provisions of any resolution or trust indenture
23 authorizing the issuance of bonds any moneys in any such
24 sinking fund in excess of an amount equal to one year's
25 interest on the bonds then outstanding secured by such sinking
26 fund may be applied to the purchase or redemption of bonds. All

1 such bonds so redeemed or purchased shall forthwith be
2 cancelled and shall not again be issued. No person shall be
3 permitted to use any toll highway without paying the toll
4 established under this Section except when on official Toll
5 Highway Authority business which includes police and other
6 emergency vehicles. However, any law enforcement agency
7 vehicle, fire department vehicle, public or private ambulance
8 service vehicle engaged in the performance of an emergency
9 service or duty that necessitates the use of the toll highway
10 system, or other emergency vehicle that is plainly marked
11 shall not be required to pay a toll to use a toll highway. A
12 law enforcement, fire protection, or emergency services
13 officer driving a law enforcement, fire protection, emergency
14 services agency vehicle, or public or private ambulance
15 service vehicle engaging in the performance of emergency
16 services or duties that is not plainly marked must present an
17 Official Permit Card which the law enforcement, fire
18 protection, or emergency services officer receives from his or
19 her law enforcement, fire protection, emergency services
20 agency, or public or private ambulance service in order to use
21 a toll highway without paying the toll. A law enforcement,
22 fire protection, emergency services agency, or public or
23 private ambulance service engaging in the performance of
24 emergency services or duties must apply to the Authority to
25 receive a permit, and the Authority shall adopt rules for the
26 issuance of a permit, that allows public or private ambulance

1 service vehicles engaged in the performance of emergency
2 services or duties that necessitate the use of the toll
3 highway system and all law enforcement, fire protection, or
4 emergency services agency vehicles of the law enforcement,
5 fire protection, or emergency services agency to use any toll
6 highway without paying the toll established under this
7 Section. The Authority shall maintain in its office a list of
8 all persons that are authorized to use any toll highway
9 without charge when on official business of the Authority and
10 such list shall be open to the public for inspection. In
11 recognition of the unique role of public transportation in
12 providing effective transportation in the Authority's service
13 region, and to give effect to the exemption set forth in
14 subsection (b) of Section 2.06 of the Regional Transportation
15 Authority Act, the following vehicles may use any toll highway
16 without paying the toll: (1) a vehicle owned or operated by the
17 Suburban Bus Division of the Regional Transportation Authority
18 that is being used to transport passengers for hire; and (2)
19 any revenue vehicle that is owned or operated by a Mass Transit
20 District created under Section 3 of the Local Mass Transit
21 District Act and running regular scheduled service.

24 General Assembly to allow toll revenues from the toll highway
25 system to be used to pay a portion of the cost of the

8 by a Mass Transit District created under Section 3 of the Local
9 Mass Transit District Act and running regular scheduled
10 service.

11 The toll rates established under this Section shall be
12 included on each electronic sign operated by the Authority
13 that is located on a toll highway within this State.

22 Section 95. No acceleration or delay. Where this Act makes
