SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates the sum of \$2,100,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a grant to Safer Pathways to support the Supportive Reentry Network Collaborative. Effective July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
6 the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
7 grant to Safer Pathways to support the Supportive Reentry
8 Network Collaborative, an integrated network that unifies
9 clinical care, behavioral health, housing, employment,
10 identification restoration, legal benefit access, and care
11 coordination into one accountable system that connects people
12 who are 90 days pre-release through 12 months and beyond of
13 post-release from incarceration to health care, behavioral
14 health, stabilization supports, employment and housing using
15 close-loop referrals, shared metrics, and a unified data
16 system.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
18 2026.
