2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 3518, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment  
4 No. 2, on page 7, immediately below line 17, by inserting the  
5 following:

6 ""State agency" has the meaning given to that term in  
7 Section 1-15.100 of the Illinois Procurement Code."; and

8 on page 15, line 8, after "Code", by inserting "and include the  
9 species of hardwood and country of origin"; and

10 on page 18, line 13, after "officer", by inserting "appointed  
11 pursuant to Section 10-20 of the Illinois Procurement Code";  
12 and

13 on page 19, by replacing lines 17 through 23 with the  
14 following:

15 "(c) Each State agency shall report violations of this Act

1 to the chief procurement officers appointed pursuant to  
2 Section 10-20 of the Illinois Procurement Code. The chief  
3 procurement officers may suspend the contractor or  
4 subcontractor from having a contract for supplies and services  
5 subject to this Act. Suspension shall be for cause and may be  
6 for a period of up to 10 years at the discretion of the  
7 applicable chief procurement officer. Contractors or  
8 subcontractors may be debarred in accordance with rules  
9 promulgated by the chief procurement officer or as otherwise  
10 provided by law.

11 Any contract subject to this Act that was procured under  
12 the Illinois Procurement Code shall be subject to Section  
13 50-60 of the Illinois Procurement Code.".
