1 AN ACT concerning government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by adding Section 7 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/7 new)
- Sec. 7. Indigenous Peoples Day. The last Monday in

 8 September of each year is designated as Indigenous Peoples Day

 9 to be observed throughout the State as a day to recognize the

 10 contributions of indigenous peoples with suitable ceremony and

 11 fellowship designed to promote greater understanding and

 12 kinship between indigenous peoples and non-indigenous peoples

 13 of the State of Illinois.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
