| 9 | (a) As used in this Section: |
| 10 | "Digital printing" means a printing method which includes, |
| 11 | but is not limited to, the electrostatic process of |
| 12 | transferring ink or toner to a substrate. This process may |
| 13 | involve the use of photo imaging plates, photoreceptor drums, |
| 14 | or belts which hold an electrostatic charge. "Digital printing" |
| 15 | is also defined as a process of transferring ink through a |
| 16 | print head directly to a substrate, as is done with ink-jet |

1 printers.

2 <u>"Offset printing" means lithography, flexography, gravure,</u>
3 or letterpress. "Offset printing" involves the process of
4 <u>transferring ink through static or fixed image plates using an</u>
5 <u>impact method of pressing ink into a substrate.</u>

6 <u>(b)</u> Contracts requiring the procurement of <u>offset</u> printing 7 services shall specify the use of soybean oil-based ink <u>or</u> 8 <u>veqetable oil-based ink</u> unless a State purchasing officer 9 determines that another type of ink is required to assure high 10 quality and reasonable pricing of the printed product.
