1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
29-9 as follows:

(10 ILCS 5/29-9) (from Ch. 46, par. 29-9) 6 7 Sec. 29-9. Unlawful observation of voting. Except as permitted by this Code, any person who knowingly marks his 8 9 ballot or casts his vote on a voting machine or voting device so that it can be observed by another person, and any person 10 11 who knowingly observes another person lawfully marking a ballot or lawfully casting his vote on a voting machine or voting 12 device, shall be quilty of a Class 4 felony. Nothing in this 13 14 Section shall prohibit a person from photographing his or her own ballot at any time during the voting process or from 15 16 viewing a photograph of a completed or partially completed 17 ballot; however, a person who gives, promises to give, or receives any money or other valuable consideration in 18

19 <u>connection with the dissemination or viewing of such a</u> 20 photograph shall be guilty of a Class 4 felony.
