# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
adding Section 195 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 490/195 new)

Sec. 195. Illinois Constitution Day. August 26th of each
year is designated as Illinois Constitution Day, to be observed
throughout the State as a day to commemorate August 26, 1818 as
the day Illinois ratified its first State Constitution.
