2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1595 by replacing

3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Nursing Mothers in the Workplace Act is

5 amended by changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 260/10)

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Sec. 10. Break time for nursing mothers. An employer shall provide reasonable unpaid break time each day to an employee who needs to express breast milk for her nursing infant child each time the employee has the need to express milk for one year after the child's birth. The break time may must, if possible, run concurrently with any break time already provided to the employee. An employer may not reduce an employee's pay or benefit time used for the purpose of expressing milk or nursing a baby. An employer shall is not required to provide reasonable break time as needed by the employee unless under
