Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the 6 7 General Revenue Fund for the objects and purposes hereinafter 8 named to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the State 9 Employees' Retirement System: SOCIAL SECURITY DIVISION 10 11 12 For State Contributions to 13 14 15 16 17 18 For Equipment0 For Electronic Data Processing500 19 For Telecommunications Services300 20 21 Total \$77,200 22 CENTRAL OFFICE

- 3 ARTICLE 2
- 4 Section 1. The sum of \$1,286,248,340, or so much thereof
- 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 6 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State Employees' Retirement
- 7 System of Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided
- 8 by law.
- 9 Section 5. The sum of \$136,766,000, or so much thereof as
- 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 11 to the Board of Trustees of the Judges Retirement System of
- 12 Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided by law.
- 13 Section 10. The sum of \$23,679,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 15 to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly Retirement
- 16 System for the State's contribution, as provided by law.
- 17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
- 18 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
- 19 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
