1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4259

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4259, AS AMENDED, by
3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
6 changing Section 8-102 and by adding Section 3-414.5 as
7 follows:

8 (625 ILCS 5/3-414.5 new)

9 Sec. 3-414.5. Multi-year registration.

10 (a) The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, permit the
11 owner of a motor vehicle of the first division, a motor vehicle
12 of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds, or
13 a motor vehicle of the second division applying for a C Class
14 registration plate to register the motor vehicle for a period
15 of 2 years.

16 (1) If the vehicle to be registered is required to

1 undergo emissions inspections, the 2-year registration
2 must coincide with the emissions inspection cycle.

3 (2) An applicant for a 2-year registration shall apply
4 online or by completing and mailing the appropriate 2-year
5 registration application form to the address indicated on
6 the form.

7 (3) The owner of a vehicle with a 2-year registration
8 may transfer that registration to another vehicle with the
9 same emissions inspection cycle, if applicable. The owner
10 of a vehicle with a 2-year registration who discontinues
11 use of the registration before the expiration of the 2-year
12 period is not entitled to a complete or prorated refund of
13 the registration fee.

14 (4) The fee for a 2-year registration shall be twice
15 the applicable annual registration fee for the vehicle
16 being registered.

17 (b) Beginning January 1, 2021, the Secretary shall permit
18 the owner of a trailer to register the trailer for a period of
19 one year or for an extended registration period of up to 5
20 years.

21 (1) The extended trailer registration shall be based on
22 a recurring 5-year registration period. The trailer owner
23 may apply for an extended registration for the number of
24 years remaining in the current 5-year cycle at the time of
25 the registration application.

26 (2) An applicant for an extended trailer registration

1 shall apply online or by completing and mailing the
2 appropriate extended trailer registration application form
3 to the address indicated on the form.

4 (3) The owner of a trailer with an extended
5 registration may transfer that registration to another
6 trailer of the same weight class. The owner of a trailer
7 with an extended registration who discontinues use of the
8 registration before the registration period expires is not
9 entitled to a complete or prorated refund of the
10 registration fee.

11 (4) The fee for an extended registration shall be the
12 same as the applicable annual registration fee for the
13 trailer being registered, multiplied by the number of years
14 or partial years remaining in the current 5-year cycle at
15 the time of the registration application.

16 (c) The Secretary of State shall adopt rules to implement
17 this Section.

19 Sec. 8-102. Alternate methods of giving proof.

20 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), proof ~~Proof~~ of
21 financial responsibility, when required under Section 8-101 or
22 8-101.1, may be given by filing with the Secretary of State one
23 of the following:

24 1. A bond as provided in Section 8-103;

25 2. An insurance policy or other proof of insurance in a

1 form to be prescribed by the Secretary as provided in
2 Section 8-108;

3 3. A certificate of self-insurance issued by the
4 Director;

5 4. A certificate of self-insurance issued to the
6 Regional Transportation Authority by the Director naming
7 municipal or non-municipal public carriers included
8 therein;

9 5. A certificate of coverage issued by an
10 intergovernmental risk management association evidencing
11 coverages which meet or exceed the amounts required under
12 this Code.

13 (b) Beginning January 1, 2020, in lieu of filing the
14 documents required by subsection (a), each owner of a vehicle
15 required to obtain minimum liability insurance under Section
16 8-101 or 8-101.1 shall attest that the vehicle is insured in at
17 least the minimum required amount.

18 (1) The Secretary shall create a form on which the
19 vehicle owner shall attest that the vehicle is insured in
20 at least the minimum required amount. The attestation form
21 shall be submitted with each registration application.

22 (2) The attestation form shall be valid for the full
23 registration period; however, if at any time the Secretary
24 has reason to believe that the owner does not have the
25 minimum required amount of insurance for a vehicle, the
26 Secretary may require the owner to file with the Secretary

1 documentation as set forth in subsection (a) of this
2 Section.

3 (3) If the owner fails to provide the required
4 documentation within 7 calendar days after the request is
5 made, the Secretary may suspend the vehicle registration.
6 The registration shall remain suspended until such time as
7 the required documentation is provided to and reviewed by
8 the Secretary.

9 (4) The owner of a vehicle that is self-insured shall
10 attest that the funds available to pay liability claims
11 related to the operation of the vehicle are equivalent to
12 or greater than the minimum liability insurance
13 requirements under Section 8-101 or 8-101.1.

14 (c) The Secretary of State shall adopt rules to implement
15 this Section.
