1 AN ACT concerning government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by adding Section 195 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/195 new)
- Sec. 195. Day of the Horse. The fifth day of March of each
 year shall be designated as the Day of the Horse, to be
 observed throughout the State as a day to encourage citizens to
 honor and celebrate the role of equines in the history and
 character of Illinois, and to recognize the benefits of the
 equine industry to the economy, agriculture, tourism, and
