

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Military Code of Illinois is amended by
5 changing Section 22-3 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 1805/22-3) (from Ch. 129, par. 220.22-3)

7 Sec. 22-3. All monies received from the sale of Illinois
8 National Guard facilities and lands pursuant to authority
9 contained in Section 22-2, all moneys received from the
10 transfer or exchange of any realty under the control of the
11 Department pursuant to authority contained in Section 22-5, and
12 all funds received from the federal government under terms of
13 the Federal Master Cooperative Agreement related to
14 constructing and maintaining real property between the
15 Department of Military Affairs and the United States Property
16 and Fiscal Officer for Illinois shall be paid into the State
17 Treasury without delay and shall be deposited ~~covered~~ into a
18 special fund to be known as the Illinois National Guard
19 Construction Fund. The monies in this fund shall be used
20 exclusively by the Adjutant General for the purpose of
21 acquiring building sites, ~~and~~ constructing new facilities,
22 rehabilitating existing facilities, and making other capital
23 improvements. Expenditures from this fund shall be subject to

1 appropriation by the General Assembly ~~and written release by~~
2 ~~the Governor.~~
