## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2605/2605-610 new 105 ILCS 5/10-20.67 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.60 new

Amends the Department of State Police Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois and the School Code. Requires the Department of State Police to annually determine the 5 most frequently committed crimes by minors and any criminal, civil, or other penalties associated with these crimes, compile a report of this information, and make the report publicly available on the Department's website. Provides that the Chicago Board of Education shall require each high school to annually distribute the report to its students electronically or in the form of a letter; permits other school boards to require a high school to distribute the report. Provides that if a high school distributes the report electronically, it shall obtain from its students electronic acknowledgment of receipt of the report.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of State Police Law of the Civil
Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section
2605-610 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 2605/2605-610 new)

8 <u>Sec. 2605-610. Creation of list of top crimes committed by</u> 9 <u>minors. The Department shall annually determine the 5 most</u> 10 <u>frequently committed crimes by minors and any criminal, civil,</u> 11 <u>or other penalties associated with these crimes, compile a</u> 12 <u>report of this information, and make the report publicly</u> 13 <u>available on the Department's website.</u>

Section 10. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 15 10-20.67 and 34-18.60 as follows:

16 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.67 new) Sec. 10-20.67. Distribution of list of top crimes committed by minors. The school board of any district that maintains grades 9 through 12 may require each high school to annually distribute to its students, electronically or in the form of a letter, the report found on the Department of State Police's - 2 - LRB100 19590 AXK 34860 b

If a high school distributes the report under this Section electronically, it shall obtain from its students electronic acknowledgment of receipt of the report.

8 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.60 new) 9 Sec. 34-18.60. Distribution of list of top crimes committed 10 by minors. The board shall require each high school to annually 11 distribute to its students, electronically or in the form of a 12 letter, the report found on the Department of State Police's 13 website that lists the 5 most frequently committed crimes by minors and any criminal, civil, or other penalties associated 14 15 with these crimes, as compiled under Section 2605-610 of the 16 Department of State Police Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. If a high school distributes the report under this 17 18 Section electronically, it shall obtain from its students 19 electronic acknowledgment of receipt of the report.
