SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/6A-7

from Ch. 46, par. 6A-7

Amends the Election Code. Provides that a county board in a county in which there is no city, village, or incorporated town with a board of election commissioners that has established a county board of election commissioners may, by ordinance or resolution, dissolve the county board of election commissioners and transfer its functions to the county clerk.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
5 6A-7 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/6A-7) (from Ch. 46, par. 6A-7)

7 Sec. 6A-7. Dissolution.

8 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), any ~~Any~~ county
9 which has established a board of election commissioners may
10 subsequently vote to dissolve ~~abandon~~ such board in the same
11 manner as provided in Article 6 for cities, villages and
12 incorporated towns, except that the petition to the circuit
13 court to submit to the vote of the electors of the county the
14 proposition to dissolve ~~abandon~~ the board of election
15 commissioners shall be signed by at least 10% of the registered
16 voters of the county.

17 (b) A county board in a county that has established a
18 county board of election commissioners in accordance with
19 subsection (a) of Section 6A-1 of the Election Code may, by
20 ordinance or resolution, dissolve the county board of election
21 commissioners and transfer its functions to the county clerk.
