## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/6A-7

from Ch. 46, par. 6A-7

Amends the Election Code. Provides that a county board in a county in which there is no city, village, or incorporated town with a board of election commissioners that has established a county board of election commissioners may, by ordinance or resolution, dissolve the county board of election commissioners and transfer its functions to the county clerk.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section 6A-7 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/6A-7) (from Ch. 46, par. 6A-7)
- 7 Sec. 6A-7. <u>Dissolution</u>.
- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), any Any county 8 which has established a board of election commissioners may subsequently vote to dissolve abandon such board in the same 10 manner as provided in Article 6 for cities, villages and 11 incorporated towns, except that the petition to the circuit 12 court to submit to the vote of the electors of the county the 13 14 proposition to dissolve abandon the board of election commissioners shall be signed by at least 10% of the registered 15 16 voters of the county.
  - (b) A county board in a county that has established a county board of election commissioners in accordance with subsection (a) of Section 6A-1 of the Election Code may, by ordinance or resolution, dissolve the county board of election commissioners and transfer its functions to the county clerk.
