1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5175

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 5175 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section  
5 24-8 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/24-8) (from Ch. 122, par. 24-8)

7 Sec. 24-8. Minimum salary. In fixing the salaries of  
8 teachers, school boards shall pay those who serve on a  
9 full-time basis not less than a rate for the school year that  
10 is based upon training completed in a recognized institution of  
11 higher learning, as follows: for the school year beginning July  
12 1, 1980 and thereafter, less than a bachelor's degree, \$9,000;  
13 120 semester hours or more and a bachelor's degree, \$10,000;  
14 150 semester hours or more and a master's degree, \$11,000.  
15 Beginning July 1, 2018, in fixing the salaries of teachers, it  
16 shall be the goal of the State of Illinois to ensure that the

1 minimum, full-time basis rate paid under this paragraph shall  
2 be \$40,000 per year by July 1, 2025.

3       Based upon previous public school experience in this State  
4 or any other state, territory, dependency or possession of the  
5 United States, or in schools operated by or under the auspices  
6 of the United States, teachers who serve on a full-time basis  
7 shall have their salaries increased to at least the following  
8 amounts above the starting salary for a teacher in such  
9 district in the same classification: with less than a  
10 bachelor's degree, \$750 after 5 years; with 120 semester hours  
11 or more and a bachelor's degree, \$1,000 after 5 years and  
12 \$1,600 after 8 years; with 150 semester hours or more and a  
13 master's degree, \$1,250 after 5 years, \$2,000 after 8 years and  
14 \$2,750 after 13 years.

15       For the purpose of this Section a teacher's salary shall  
16 include any amount paid by the school district on behalf of the  
17 teacher, as teacher contributions, to the Teachers' Retirement  
18 System of the State of Illinois.

19       If a school board establishes a schedule for teachers'  
20 salaries based on education and experience, not inconsistent  
21 with this Section, all certificated nurses employed by that  
22 board shall be paid in accordance with the provisions of such  
23 schedule.

24       For purposes of this Section, a teacher who submits a  
25 certificate of completion to the school office prior to the  
26 first day of the school term shall be considered to have the

1 degree stated in such certificate.

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
