SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 200/27-5

Amends the Property Tax Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the Special Service Area Tax Law.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by changing
5 Section 27-5 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 200/27-5)

7 Sec. 27-5. Short title; definitions. This Article may be
8 cited as the ~~the~~ Special Service Area Tax Law.

9 When used in this Article:

10 "Services contract" means an agreement between a service
11 provider agency and a municipality or county for the purpose of
12 providing special services in and for a special service area.

13 "Service provider agency" means an entity that enters into
14 a services contract with a municipality or county for the
15 purpose of providing special services in and for a special
16 service area.

17 "Special Service Area" means a contiguous area within a
18 municipality or county in which special governmental services
19 are provided in addition to those services provided generally
20 throughout the municipality or county, the cost of the special
21 services to be paid from revenues collected from taxes levied
22 or imposed upon property within that area. Territory shall be
23 considered contiguous for purposes of this Article even though

1 certain completely surrounded portions of the territory are
2 excluded from the special service area. A county may create a
3 special service area within a municipality or municipalities
4 when the municipality or municipalities consent to the creation
5 of the special service area. A municipality may create a
6 special service area within a municipality and the
7 unincorporated area of a county or within another municipality
8 when the county or other municipality consents to the creation
9 of the special service area.

10 "Special service area commission" means a local board
11 established by the corporate authorities of a municipality or
12 county for the purpose of managing a particular special service
13 area.

14 "Special Services" means all forms of services pertaining
15 to the government and affairs of the municipality or county,
16 including but not limited to weather modification and
17 improvements permissible under Article 9 of the Illinois
18 Municipal Code, and contracts for the supply of water as
19 described in Section 11-124-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code
20 which may be entered into by the municipality or by the county
21 on behalf of a county service area.
