## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/22-85 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that State funds may not be used to fund a non-profit teacher training program that has (i) a 2-year residency requirement for a corps member of Teach for America and (ii) no requirements for formal teacher training prior to admitting an individual into the program. Effective July 1, 2018.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
22-85 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/22-85 new)

7 Sec. 22-85. Non-profit teacher training program; State funds. State funds may not be used to fund a non-profit teacher 8 9 training program that has (i) a 2-year residency requirement for a corps member of Teach for America and (ii) no 10 requirements for formal teacher training prior to admitting an 11 12 individual into the program. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prevent State funding for an Alternative Educator 13 14 Licensure Program for Teachers under Section 21B-50 of this 15 Code.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2018.
