SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 115/0.01 110 ILCS 115/0.05 new 30 ILCS 805/8.42 new from Ch. 144, par. 251.9

Amends the University Credit and Retail Sales Act. Changes the short title of the Act to the Higher Education Institution Credit and Retail Sales Act. Defines "State institution of higher learning" to mean a university, college, community college, or junior college in this State that is publicly supported by taxes levied and collected within the State on income, sales, or property. Provides that "State institution of higher learning" does not include a post-secondary educational institution as defined under the Private College Act. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement. Effective immediately.

STATE MANDATES ACT MAY REQUIRE REIMBURSEMENT 1 AN ACT concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 12 Sec. 0.05. State institution of higher learning defined.
- 13 "State institution of higher learning" means a university,
- 14 college, community college, or junior college in this State
- 15 that is publicly supported by taxes levied and collected within
- 16 the State on income, sales, or property. "State institution of
- 17 higher learning" does not include a post-secondary educational
- institution as defined under the Private College Act.
- 19 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
- 20 Section 8.42 as follows:

- 1 (30 ILCS 805/8.42 new)
- Sec. 8.42. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
- 4 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
- 5 the 100th General Assembly.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 7 becoming law.
