1 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The massacre at the Tree of Life Synagogue in 3 Pittsburgh shocked the world; and

WHEREAS, A peaceful sabbath service turned into a massacre
of Jewish life; families were gathered for weekly Shabbat
prayer and to welcome a child into the Jewish community when an
armed intruder opened fire inside the synagogue with an assault
rifle, slaughtering 11 Jewish congregants and wounding six
brave law enforcement officers; and

10 WHEREAS, The Jewish Caucus of the Illinois Legislature 11 condemns this anti-Semitic act and will continue to fight 12 against the hatred and violence directed at their community; 13 and

14 WHEREAS, This is not only a Jewish issue; it also affects 15 the African-American, Latino, LGBTQ, Muslim, and immigrant 16 communities, and everyone who has been the victim of white 17 nationalist violence; and

WHEREAS, Children must know that evil begets evil, and that violence begets violence; therefore, be it

- 7 RESOLVED, That we must seek to build a safe and inclusive
- 8 community, we must reject terrorism in all its forms, and we
- 9 must pass laws to protect our communities from violence and
- 10 fear; and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 12 presented to the Tree of Life Synagogue as a symbol of our
- 13 solidarity.
