## HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The opioid epidemic in Illinois and across the 3 country has headlined the news the past few years; and

WHEREAS, In Illinois alone, the Illinois Department of Public Health reports that of the 2,278 deaths from drug overdose in 2016, over 80% were from opioids, a 70% increase from 2013 and a 32% increase from 2015; and

8 WHEREAS, While we have been aware of this problem, the 9 solution has remained elusive; and

10 WHEREAS, The legal and medical communities have sought to 11 combat the crisis by properly removing expired or unwanted 12 pills from the population through drug drop-off boxes and mail 13 back programs; and

14 WHEREAS, Both ways have seen initial success throughout a 15 number of states, but the drop-off boxes have been further 16 initiated than mail back programs here in Illinois, to the 17 point where some have been overflowing; and

18 WHEREAS, Pharmacies have started to install the boxes on 19 their own initiative, as a convenient location and alternative 20 for those who may fear using one in a police station; and 1 WHEREAS, It may be costly or problematic to require these 2 boxes, but for those who would like to install one voluntarily, 3 over \$281,000 has accrued in the Comptroller's Prescription 4 Pill and Drug Disposal Fund; and

5 WHEREAS, The changes adding drug disposal drop-off boxes 6 and mail-back programs to this fund were established under 20 7 ILCS 3930/9.3; and

8 WHEREAS, The Illinois Criminal Justice Information 9 Authority was charged with adopting rules and establishing 10 guidelines for grants by July 1, 2016, but no funds have been 11 released to date; and

12 WHEREAS, It would be in the best interest of the citizens 13 of Illinois to have these funds used for their intended 14 purposes; therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE 16 HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we 17 urge the Office of the Comptroller to look into why these funds 18 have yet to be released and work to release them as soon as may 19 be possible; and be it further
